The awards available are listed below.

THE DE HAVILLAND SCHOLARSHIP

This award is for a young person who wishes to learn to fly on a DH 82a Tiger Moth Aircraft at the Cambridge Flying Group.

THE AEROTRON SCHOLARSHIP

This award is to sponsor a young aviation mechanic or technician who wishes to take their Part 66 engineer's licence.

THE VICTOR GAUNTLET SCHOLARSHIP and THE ERIC 'WINKLE' BROWN SCHOLARSHIP

These awards are for a young person to learn or enhance their vintage aviation engineering and maintenance skills with the specific aim of preserving heritage skills. The awards may also be awarded to fund an individual to take a course, buy equipment or to fund a person running a specialist course to train others in the field of vintage aircraft maintenance.

THE SIR SYDNEY CAMM SCHOLARSHIP

This award is to generally help a young person studying for a first (Bachelors) degree or wishing to develop a foundation or other qualification into a degree qualification to enhance their learning experience.

THE SIR FREDERICK HANDLEY PAGE SCHOLARSHIP

This award is for a young person studying for a master's degree to help generally or to add something extra to their course and to enhance their learning experience.

THE ERIC BEVERLEY SCHOLARSHIP

This award is for a young person studying for a PhD to add something extra to their course and to enhance their whole PhD study experience.
